PRODUCER

In 1976, Jean and Christiane Bellanger fell in love with Château Roquefort and breathed new life into this magnificent Entre-Deux-Mers property. It covers 240 hectares (including 100 hectares of grape vines) at the heart of Entre-Deux-Mers between the Garonne and the Dordogne, in a magnificent region known by some as 'little Tuscany.' Hills and steep slopes around a limestone plateau offer the perfect setting for grape vines to flourish. The Bellanger family has long opted to preserve national biodiversity with a collection of forests, meadows and pasture. This balance is one of the particular features which make Château Roquefort a remarkable Entre-Deux-Mers estate.

VINEYARDS

Located at the highest point of the Gironde at Castelviel, Sauvignon Blanc thrives on the chalky-clay soil.

WINEMAKING

Short maceration on skins and low temperature fermentation in stainless steel vats.

TASTING NOTES

The picture of an oyster shell on this bottle's label tells you everything you need to know. A bright, zesty, dry Sauvignon Blanc from a high, chalky vineyard at Château Roquefort; a wine that partners beautifully with shellfish.
