Pinot Nero Blauburgunder, Kellerei Kurtatsch 2023

Alto Adige, Italy



PRODUCER

Kellerei Kurtatsch is a medium sized co-operative working with 190 family farms cultivating 190 hectares in north-east Italy's Alto Adige. Bringing together decades of vineyard knowledge and modern, precision winemaking, whilst working as sustainably as possible, their philosophy is to produce distinctive wines that reflect their mountain origins.

VINEYARDS

Pinot Noir has exacting site requirements. Here, the variety thrives in vineyards with western exposure in the southernmost part of Alto Adige, where the micro-climate is comfortably cool. Long-lasting, mild evening sun brings forth the typical Burgundy aromas on these clayey soils.

WINEMAKING

Short, cold maceration, with fermentation in stainless steel followed by malolactic fermentation and ageing in concrete tanks.

TASTING NOTES

Glistening, pale ruby-purple colour, aromas are perfumed and pure, recalling fresh, ripe, red berries. Palate has beautiful energy, intensity and juiciness. Medium bodied, there is excellent depth, an attractive, rounded texture, leading to a long-flavoured, bright finish.
