Vosne-Romanée "Aux Communes" Domaine Seguin-Manuel 2018

Burgundy, France



PRODUCER

Seguin-Manuel was founded in 1824, however its links with Burgundy vineyards date back as far as 1720. More recently, the business was bought by Thibaut Marion, who comes from an old Beaune family. The firm was originally based in Savigny, in a 14th century vat-house with vaulted cellars which had been built by the Abbey of Cîteaux. Thibaut has now moved to a more practical, modern site in Beaune and has taken great strides in fine-tuning the wine-making, with improvements being striking in the domaine's wines. He has also expanded the estate's vineyard holdings to 8.5 hectares.

VINEYARDS

Brown clay and limestone, sediments and gravels on its upper part. Located on the Côte de Nuits, near the most famous crus of Burgundy: "La Tâche" and "Romanée-Conti."

WINEMAKING

Grapes hand-harvested and 100% de-stemmed. Aged in 25% new oak barrels for 16 months.

TASTING NOTES

Delicate aromas of black and red berries and soft spices on the nose. The natural balance with fine tannins enhance the subtle aromas until the long aftertaste. Power and subtlety in the same wine!
